Types of Data collected

Among the types of Personal Data that AMBAYO collects, by itself or through third parties, there are: Trackers; Usage Data; device information; number of sessions; session duration; operating systems; first name; last name; email address; payment info; answers to questions; clicks; keypress events; motion sensor events; mouse movements; scroll position; touch events; password.

Complete details on each type of Personal Data collected are provided in the dedicated sections of this privacy policy or by specific explanation texts displayed prior to the Data collection.

Personal Data may be freely provided by the User, or, in case of Usage Data, collected automatically when using AMBAYO.

Unless specified otherwise, all Data requested by AMBAYO is mandatory and failure to provide this Data may make it impossible for AMBAYO to provide its services. In cases where AMBAYO specifically states that some Data is not mandatory, Users are free not to communicate this Data without consequences to the availability or the functioning of the Service.

Users who are uncertain about which Personal Data is mandatory are welcome to contact the Owner.

Any use of Cookies – or of other tracking tools — by AMBAYO or by the owners of third-party services used by AMBAYO serves the purpose of providing the Service required by the User, in addition to any other purposes described in the present document and in the Cookie Policy.

Users are responsible for any third-party Personal Data obtained, published or shared through AMBAYO.

Mode and place of processing the Data

Methods of processing

The Owner takes appropriate security measures to prevent unauthorized access, disclosure, modification, or unauthorized destruction of the Data.

The Data processing is carried out using computers and/or IT enabled tools, following organizational procedures and modes strictly related to the purposes indicated. In addition to the Owner, in some cases, the Data may be accessible to certain types of persons in charge, involved with the operation of AMBAYO (administration, sales, marketing, legal, system administration) or external parties (such as third-party technical service providers, mail carriers, hosting providers, IT companies, communications agencies) appointed, if necessary, as Data Processors by the Owner. The updated list of these parties may be requested from the Owner at any time.

Place

The Data is processed at the Owner's operating offices and in any other places where the parties involved in the processing are located.

Depending on the User's location, data transfers may involve transferring the User's Data to a country other than their own. To find out more about the place of processing of such transferred Data, Users can check the section containing details about the processing of Personal Data.

Retention time

Unless specified otherwise in this document, Personal Data shall be processed and stored for as long as required by the purpose they have been collected for and may be retained for longer due to applicable legal obligation or based on the Users' consent.

The purposes of processing

The Data concerning the User is collected to allow the Owner to provide its Service, comply with its legal obligations, respond to enforcement requests, protect its rights and interests (or those of its Users or third parties), detect any malicious or fraudulent activity, as well as the following: Hosting and backend infrastructure, Registration and authentication, Handling payments, Contacting the User, Remarketing and behavioral targeting, Social features, Analytics, Managing contacts and sending messages, User database management, Handling finance and accounting, Advertising, Spam and bots protection, Traffic optimization and distribution, Displaying content from external platforms, Infrastructure monitoring, Content performance and features testing (A/B testing), Access to third-party accounts and Registration and authentication provided directly by AMBAYO.

For specific information about the Personal Data used for each purpose, the User may refer to the section “Detailed information on the processing of Personal Data”.

Facebook permissions asked by AMBAYO

AMBAYO may ask for some Facebook permissions allowing it to perform actions with the User's Facebook account and to retrieve information, including Personal Data, from it. This service allows AMBAYO to connect with the User's account on the Facebook social network, provided by Facebook Inc.

The permissions asked are the following:

Basic information

By default, this includes certain User's Data such as id, name, picture, gender, and their locale. Certain connections of the User, such as the Friends, are also available. If the User has made more of their Data public, more information will be available.

device information

Email

Provides access to the User's primary email address.

Trackers

Tracker indicates any technology - e.g Cookies, unique identifiers, web beacons, embedded scripts, e-tags and fingerprinting - that enables the tracking of Users, for example by accessing or storing information on the User's device.

Usage Data

Detailed information on the processing of Personal Data

Personal Data is collected for the following purposes and using the following services:

Access to third-party accounts

This type of service allows AMBAYO to access Data from your account on a third-party service and perform actions with it. These services are not activated automatically, but require explicit authorization by the User.

Facebook account access (Meta Platforms, Inc.)

This service allows AMBAYO to connect with the User's account on the Facebook social network, provided by Meta Platforms, Inc.

Permissions asked: device information; Email; Trackers; Usage Data.

Category of Personal Information collected according to the CCPA: identifiers; internet or other electronic network activity information.

Advertising

This type of service allows User Data to be utilized for advertising communication purposes. These communications are displayed in the form of banners and other advertisements on AMBAYO, possibly based on User interests. This does not mean

Google Analytics for Firebase (for apps) or Firebase Analytics is an analytics service provided by Google LLC. **In order to understand Google's use of Data, consult [Google's partner policy](#).**

Firebase Analytics may share Data with other tools provided by Firebase, such as Crash Reporting, Authentication, Remote Config or Notifications. The User may check this privacy policy to find a detailed explanation about the other tools used by the Owner.

AMBAYO uses identifiers for mobile devices and technologies similar to cookies to run the Firebase Analytics service.

Users may opt-out of certain Firebase features through applicable device settings, such as the device advertising settings for mobile phones or by following the instructions in other Firebase related sections of this privacy policy, if available.

QuickBooks

We use the third-party service QuickBooks to provide us with financial analytics services.

While you make payment transaction on AMBAYO, our analytics service provider collects and makes us available financial analytics data that allows us to see what products and services AMBAYO users purchase, as well as forecast and improve AMBAYO. When we process your analytics data that is personal data, we rely on the 'legitimate interest' (i.e., to analyse, improve, and protect AMBAYO) and 'your consent' bases.

Contacting the User

AMBAYO Enquiries

When you contact us by email or completing the contact form available on AMBAYO, we collect your first name, last name, email address, and any information that you provide in your message. We use such data to respond to your enquiries and provide you with the requested information. The legal bases on which we rely are 'pursuing our legitimate interests' (i.e., to build our client base and promote AMBAYO) and 'your consent' (for optional personal data). We will store this data until you stop communicating with us, unless your data is necessary for further purposes like concluding a service contract, in which case it will keep it as long as necessary for the intended purposes. If you do not provide the required data, we will not be able to respond to your inquiry.

Content performance and features testing (A/B testing)

The services contained in this section allow the Owner to track and analyze the User response concerning web traffic or behavior regarding changes to the structure, text or any other component of AMBAYO.

Firebase Remote Config (Google LLC)

Firebase Remote Config is an A/B testing and configuration service provided by Google LLC.

Personal Data processed: various types of Data as specified in the privacy policy of the service.

Place of processing: United States – [Privacy Policy](#).

Category of Personal Information collected according to the CCPA: identifiers.

Displaying content from external platforms

This type of service allows you to view content hosted on external platforms directly from the pages of AMBAYO and interact with them. Such services are often referred to as widgets, which are small elements placed on a website or app. They provide specific information or perform a particular function and often allow for user interaction. This type of service might still collect web traffic data for the pages where the service is installed, even when Users do not use it.

Font Awesome (Fonticons, Inc.)

Font Awesome is a typeface visualization service provided by Fonticons, Inc. that allows AMBAYO to incorporate content of this kind on its pages.

Handling finance and accounting

QuickBooks

We use QuickBooks as our third-party accounting service and software provider. Therefore, our financial records, including your order and payment information, may be processed by QuickBooks. We use QuickBooks in order to process your orders, maintain our business records, and comply with our legal obligations.

Handling payments

Unless otherwise specified, AMBAYO processes any payments by credit card, bank transfer or other means via external payment service providers. In general and unless where otherwise stated, Users are requested to provide their payment details and personal information directly to such payment service providers. AMBAYO isn't involved in the collection and processing of such information: instead, it will only receive a notification by the relevant payment service provider as to whether payment has been successfully completed.

Payment Processing on AMBAYO

When you make or request a payment, our payment service providers collect your personal data that depends on the payment method chosen by you. Such information may include your full name, billing address, digital wallet codes, payment card number, CVV code, expiration month and year. We have access to a limited amount of personal data only that is disclosed to us by the payment processor. Your payment data is used to process payments and maintain our accounting records. The legal bases on which we rely are 'performing our contractual obligations' and 'pursuing our legitimate interests' (i.e., to administer and protect AMBAYO). We keep a part of your payment data that is provided to us by our payment processor for the time period prescribed by law. Your payment card details will NOT be stored, sold, shared, rented or leased to any third parties. If you do not provide the required data, we will not be able to process your payment and, therefore, you will not be able to buy or sell the products on AMBAYO.

Stripe (Stripe, Inc.)

Stripe is a payment service provided by Stripe, Inc.

Personal Data processed: email address; first name; last name; Trackers; Usage Data.

Place of processing: United States – [Privacy Policy](#).

Category of Personal Information collected according to the CCPA: identifiers; internet or other electronic network activity information.

Coinbase (Coinbase Inc.)

Coinbase is a payment service provided by Coinbase, Inc.

Personal Data processed: payment info; Trackers; Usage Data.

Place of processing: United States – [Privacy Policy](#).

Category of Personal Information collected according to the CCPA: commercial information; internet or other electronic network activity information.

Hosting and backend infrastructure

This type of service has the purpose of hosting Data and files that enable AMBAYO to run and be distributed as well as to provide a ready-made infrastructure to run specific features or parts of AMBAYO.

Some services among those listed below, if any, may work through geographically distributed servers, making it difficult to determine the actual location where the Personal Data are stored.

Infrastructure monitoring

This type of service allows AMBAYO to monitor the use and behavior of its components so its performance, operation, maintenance and troubleshooting can be improved. Which Personal Data are processed depends on the characteristics and mode

of implementation of these services, whose function is to filter the activities of AMBAYO.

Firebase Performance Monitoring (Google LLC)

Firebase Performance Monitoring is a monitoring service provided by Google LLC.

Personal Data processed: Trackers; various types of Data as specified in the privacy policy of the service.

Place of processing: United States – [Privacy Policy](#).

Category of Personal Information collected according to the CCPA: identifiers; internet or other electronic network activity information.

Managing contacts and sending messages

This type of service makes it possible to manage a database of email contacts, phone contacts or any other contact information to communicate with the User. These services may also collect data concerning the date and time when the message was viewed by the User, as well as when the User interacted with it, such as by clicking on links included in the message.

Utopia

When you contact us by using our live chat functionality, we collect your name and any information that you provide in your message. We use such data to respond to your enquiries and provide you with the requested information. The legal bases on which we rely are ‘pursuing our legitimate interests’ (i.e., to support our users) and ‘your consent’ (for optional personal data). We will store this data until you stop communicating with us, unless your data is necessary for further purposes like concluding a service contract, in which case it will be kept as long as necessary for the intended purposes. If you do not provide the required data, we will not be able to respond to your inquiry.

Firebase Cloud Messaging (Google LLC)

Firebase Cloud Messaging is a message sending service provided by Google LLC. Firebase Cloud Messaging allows the Owner to send messages and notifications to Users across platforms such as Android, iOS, and the web. Messages can be sent to single devices, groups of devices, or specific topics or User segments.

Personal Data processed: Trackers; various types of Data as specified in the privacy policy of the service.

Place of processing: United States – [Privacy Policy](#).

Category of Personal Information collected according to the CCPA: identifiers; internet or other electronic network activity information.

Firebase Notifications (Google LLC)

Firebase Notifications is a message sending service provided by Google LLC. Firebase Notifications can be integrated with Firebase Analytics to target analytics-based audiences and track opening and conversion events.

Personal Data processed: various types of Data as specified in the privacy policy of the service.

Place of processing: United States – [Privacy Policy](#).

Category of Personal Information collected according to the CCPA: identifiers.

Registration and authentication

By registering or authenticating, Users allow AMBAYO to identify them and give them access to dedicated services. Depending on what is described below, third parties may provide registration and authentication services. In this case, AMBAYO will be able to access some Data, stored by these third-party services, for registration or identification purposes. Some of the services listed below may also collect Personal Data for targeting and profiling purposes; to find out more, please refer to the description of each service.

AMBAYO Account Registration

When you register your user account by using your email address, we collect your name, email address, and phone number. When you register your user account by using your social media account (subject to availability), we have access to the personal data that your social media provider discloses to us (usually, your name, photo, and email address). We use this information to register and maintain your user account, contact you, if necessary, process your orders, and maintain our business records. The legal bases on which we rely are ‘performing a contract with you’ and ‘pursuing our legitimate interests’ (i.e., operate, analyse,

grow, protect, and administer AMBAYO). We will store your account information until you delete your account. If you do not provide the required data, we will not be able to register your account and, therefore, you will not be able to use the full functionality of AMBAYO.

AMBAYO Account Verification

After the registration of your user account, we may ask you to provide (i) a copy of your ID, in which case we will have access to your image, name, surname, date of birth, identification number, and any other information made available on your ID, (ii) a selfie with a clearly visible image of your face, and (iii) a proof of address, where we will see your address. We will use such data to verify your account for the purpose of ensuring the security of AMBAYO and its users. The legal basis on which we rely is 'pursuing our legitimate interests' (i.e., operate, protect, and administer AMBAYO). We will store account verification data for no longer than 30 days after the date of the verification. After the expiration of the said 30-day period, your verification data will be securely deleted. Your account verification details will NOT be stored longer than necessary, sold, shared, rented or leased to any third parties.

Facebook Authentication (Meta Platforms, Inc.)

Facebook Authentication is a registration and authentication service provided by Meta Platforms, Inc. and is connected to the Facebook social network.

Personal Data processed: Trackers; various types of Data as specified in the privacy policy of the service.

Place of processing: United States – [Privacy Policy](#) – [Opt out](#).

Category of Personal Information collected according to the CCPA: identifiers; internet or other electronic network activity information.

Registration and authentication provided directly by AMBAYO

By registering or authenticating, Users allow AMBAYO to identify them and give them access to dedicated services. The Personal Data is collected and stored for registration or identification purposes only. The Data collected are only those necessary for the provision of the service requested by the Users.

Direct registration (AMBAYO)

The User registers by filling out the registration form and providing the Personal Data directly to AMBAYO.

Personal Data processed: email address; password; Trackers; Usage Data.

Category of Personal Information collected according to the CCPA: identifiers; internet or other electronic network activity information.

Remarketing and behavioral targeting

This type of service allows AMBAYO and its partners to inform, optimize and serve advertising based on past use of AMBAYO by the User. This activity is facilitated by tracking Usage Data and by using Trackers to collect information which is then transferred to the partners that manage the remarketing and behavioral targeting activity. Some services offer a remarketing option based on email address lists. Services of this kind usually allow Users to opt out of such tracking. Users may learn how to opt out of interest-based advertising more generally by visiting the relevant opt-out section in this document.

Analytics

While you are browsing on AMBAYO, our analytics service provider collects and makes us available analytics data that allows us to see what kind of users access and use AMBAYO, which parts of AMBAYO you find interesting, improve our content, develop new products and services, and investigate and prevent security issues and abuse. When we process your analytics data that is personal data, we rely on the 'legitimate interest' (i.e., to analyse, improve, and protect our Website) and 'your consent' bases. The analytics data that we collect includes:

1. Your activity on AMBAYO (time of visit, pages visited, time spent on each page, clicks, scroll depth, interaction with widgets);
2. URL addresses from which you access AMBAYO;
3. Your browser type and version;
4. Your operating system;
5. Your device details;
6. Your IP address; and
7. Your other online behaviour.

Social features

Social Media Widgets

AMBAYO may include social media features, such as “Like” or “Share” buttons or other interactive mini-programs. These features may collect your IP address, which pages you are visiting on AMBAYO and the Internet, and may set a cookie to enable the feature to function properly. Social media features and widgets are provided by third-party social media providers and, therefore, your interactions with these features are governed by the privacy statement of those providers.

Firestore Dynamic Links (Google LLC)

Firestore Dynamic Links is a social feature provided by Google LLC. Dynamic Links are tracked within Firestore or Google Analytics for Firestore, which informs the Owner about the details of the User journey to and within AMBAYO.

Personal Data processed: various types of Data as specified in the privacy policy of the service.

Place of processing: United States – [Privacy Policy](#).

Category of Personal Information collected according to the CCPA: identifiers.

Spam and bots protection

This type of service analyzes the traffic of AMBAYO, potentially containing Users' Personal Data, with the purpose of filtering it from unwanted parts of traffic, messages and content that are recognized as spam or protecting it from malicious bots activities.

Google reCAPTCHA (Google LLC)

Google reCAPTCHA is a SPAM protection service provided by Google LLC. The use of reCAPTCHA is subject to the Google [privacy policy](#) and [terms of use](#).

In order to understand Google's use of Data, consult their [partner policy](#) and their [Business Data page](#).

Personal Data processed: answers to questions; clicks; keypress events; motion sensor events; mouse movements; scroll position; touch events; Trackers; Usage Data.

Place of processing: United States – [Privacy Policy](#).

Category of Personal Information collected according to the CCPA: internet or other electronic network activity information; inferences drawn from other personal information.

Traffic optimization and distribution

This type of service allows AMBAYO to distribute their content using servers located across different countries and to optimize their performance. Which Personal Data are processed depends on the characteristics and the way these services are implemented. Their function is to filter communications between AMBAYO and the User's browser. Considering the widespread distribution of this system, it is difficult to determine the locations to which the contents that may contain Personal Information of the User are transferred.

Cloudflare (Cloudflare, Inc.)

Cloudflare is a traffic optimization and distribution service provided by Cloudflare Inc. The way Cloudflare is integrated means that it filters all the traffic through AMBAYO, i.e., communication between AMBAYO and the User's browser, while also allowing analytical data from AMBAYO to be collected.

Personal Data processed: Trackers; various types of Data as specified in the privacy policy of the service.

Place of processing: United States – [Privacy Policy](#).

Category of Personal Information collected according to the CCPA: identifiers; internet or other electronic network activity information.

jsDelivr CDN (Prospect One Sp. z o.o. sp. k.)

jsDelivr CDN is a traffic optimization and distribution service provided by Prospect One Sp. z o.o. sp. k.

Personal Data processed: Usage Data.

Place of processing: Poland – [Privacy Policy](#).

Category of Personal Information collected according to the CCPA: internet or other electronic network activity information.

User database management

This type of service allows the Owner to build user profiles by starting from an email address, a personal name, or other information that the User provides to AMBAYO, as well as to track User activities through analytics features. This Personal Data may also be matched with publicly available information about the User (such as social networks' profiles) and used to build private profiles that the Owner can display and use for improving AMBAYO. Some of these services may also enable the sending of timed messages to the User, such as emails based on specific actions performed on AMBAYO.

MySQL

MySQL provides third-party database management services. Therefore, the personal data that we may need to store can be stored by MySQL for the time period specified by us. Your personal data will be stored only for pre-defined purposes, as specified in other sections of this privacy policy (e.g., registering and maintaining your account, processing your orders, maintaining our business records, complying with our legal obligations, and contacting you). MySQL does not have the right to access your personal data stored by MySQL.

Further Information for Users in the European Union

This section applies to all Users in the European Union, according to the General Data Protection Regulation (the “GDPR”), and, for such Users, supersedes any other possibly divergent or conflicting information contained in the privacy policy. Further details regarding the categories of Data processed, the purposes of processing, the categories of recipients of the Personal Data, if any, and further information about Personal Data can be found in **the section titled “Detailed information on the processing of Personal Data” within this document**.

Legal basis of processing

The Owner may process Personal Data relating to Users if one of the following applies:

- Users have given their consent for one or more specific purposes.
- provision of Data is necessary for the performance of an agreement with the User and/or for any pre-contractual obligations thereof;
- processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the Owner is subject;
- processing is related to a task that is carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the Owner;
- processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Owner or by a third party.

In any case, the Owner will gladly help to clarify the specific legal basis that applies to the processing, and in particular whether the provision of Personal Data is a statutory or contractual requirement, or a requirement necessary to enter into a contract.

Further information about retention time

Unless specified otherwise in this document, Personal Data shall be processed and stored for as long as required by the purpose they have been collected for and may be retained for longer due to applicable legal obligation or based on the Users' consent.

Therefore:

- Personal Data collected for purposes related to the performance of a contract between the Owner and the User shall be retained until such contract has been fully performed.
- Personal Data collected for the purposes of the Owner's legitimate interests shall be retained as long as needed to fulfill such purposes. Users may find specific information regarding the legitimate interests pursued by the Owner within the relevant sections of this document or by contacting the Owner.

The Owner may be allowed to retain Personal Data for a longer period whenever the User has given consent to such processing, as long as such consent is not withdrawn. Furthermore, the Owner may be obliged to retain Personal Data for a longer period

whenever required to fulfil a legal obligation or upon order of an authority.

Once the retention period expires, Personal Data shall be deleted. Therefore, the right of access, the right to erasure, the right to rectification and the right to data portability cannot be enforced after expiration of the retention period.

The rights of Users based on the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

Users may exercise certain rights regarding their Data processed by the Owner.

In particular, Users have the right to do the following, to the extent permitted by law:

- **Withdraw their consent at any time.** Users have the right to withdraw consent where they have previously given their consent to the processing of their Personal Data.
- **Object to processing of their Data.** Users have the right to object to the processing of their Data if the processing is carried out on a legal basis other than consent.
- **Access their Data.** Users have the right to learn if Data is being processed by the Owner, obtain disclosure regarding certain aspects of the processing and obtain a copy of the Data undergoing processing.

At the Users' request, the Owner will inform them about those recipients.

Your Brazilian privacy rights

You have the right to:

- obtain confirmation of the existence of processing activities on your personal information;
- access to your personal information;
- have incomplete, inaccurate or outdated personal information rectified;
- obtain the anonymization, blocking or elimination of your unnecessary or excessive personal information, or of information that is not being processed in compliance with the LGPD;
- obtain information on the possibility to provide or deny your consent and the consequences thereof;
- obtain information about the third parties with whom we share your personal information;

- obtain, upon your express request, the portability of your personal information (except for anonymized information) to another service or product provider, provided that our commercial and industrial secrets are safeguarded;

- revoke your consent at any time;

- request clear and adequate information regarding the criteria and procedures used for an automated decision; and

You will never be discriminated against, or otherwise suffer any sort of detriment, if you exercise your rights.

How to file your request

You can file your express request to exercise your rights free from any charge, at any time, by using the contact details provided in this document, or via your legal representative.

How and when we will respond to your request

We will strive to promptly respond to your requests.

In any case, should it be impossible for us to do so, we'll make sure to communicate to you the factual or legal reasons that prevent us from immediately, or otherwise ever, complying with your requests. In cases where we are not processing your personal information, we will indicate to you the physical or legal person to whom you should address your requests, if we are in the position to do so.

Should the changes affect processing activities performed on the basis of the User's consent, the Owner shall collect new consent from the User, where required.

Personal Data (or Data) / Personal Information (or Information)

Any information that directly, indirectly, or in connection with other information — including a personal identification number — allows for the identification or identifiability of a natural person.

Sensitive Personal Information

Sensitive Personal Information means any Personal Information that is not publicly available and reveals information considered sensitive according to the applicable privacy law.

Usage Data

Information collected automatically through AMBAYO (or third-party services employed in AMBAYO), which can include: the IP addresses or domain names of the computers utilized by the Users who use AMBAYO, the URI addresses (Uniform Resource Identifier), the time of the request, the method utilized to submit the request to the server, the size of the file received in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the server's answer (successful outcome, error, etc.), the country of origin, the features of the browser and the operating system utilized by the User, the various time details per visit (e.g., the time spent on each page within the Application) and the details about the path followed within the Application with special reference to the sequence of pages visited, and other parameters about the device operating system and/or the User's IT environment.

User

Data Subject

Data Controller (or Owner)

AMBAYO (or this Application)

The means by which the Personal Data of the User is collected and processed.

Service

The service provided by AMBAYO as described in the relative terms (if available) and on this site/application.

Sale

Sale means any exchange of Personal Information by the Owner to a **third party, for monetary or other valuable consideration**, as defined by the applicable privacy US state law. Sharing
